


- All deliveries for mothers who are persons under investigation for COVID-19 should be performed under airborne precautions
- Neonatal resuscitation team should don PPE for airborne precautions and stand >6 feet away from mother if feasible
- No delayed cord clamping; separate mother and neonate immediately
- Delivery team to call charge RN to report needs of baby
- Neonatal resuscitation team to doff gown and gloves upon exiting delivery room, wipe down face shields or PAPR hoods, and perform hand hygiene; N95 may be reused as long as worn under face shield
- A member of the neonatal resuscitation team will then put on gloves and wipe down the isolette with a purple top wipe
- For transport, neonatal resuscitation team to don new PPE for airborne precautions if baby on respiratory support and for droplet precautions if baby on room air
